Instrumental song is another beautiful gift in worship, one that greatly enhances the worship experience.

Our Sunday morning worship is anchored by our pipe organ: a 1967 Schantz with 27 pipe ranks. It was installed after the Chapel was built, in 1964. In 2009, the congregation undertook a major renovation of the instrument, including a new custom-built console and the addition of 50+ Walker digital voices.

Beyond the organ, our musical inventory contains the following instruments: a 5'4" Bechstein piano; a three-octave set of hand bells; a set of hand chimes; two brand new sets of drums -- a pair of congas and a pair of bongos.

But our worship services have also recently featured flute, harp, bagpipes, violins/fiddles, guitar, dulcimer and even a didgeridoo!
